2010's two biggest events were our fundraisers, raising \$7,000, and the trip to Kamina, DRC to see the children. Without your help with fundraising, the trip would not have been possible.

In summary of your accomplishments for 2010:

By the Numbers:

- > We added 2 children in January, 2010 bringing the total supported to 93.
- > Your recycling brought in over \$1,400 for our High School Scholarship Program.
- > Two of our 10 high school students graduated.
- > Ten goats were supplied for foster families through our Livestock Development Program.
- > All 93 children and 10 Scholarship Recipients were inoculated.
- > Six Board Members spent eight joyful days with the children in the DRC.

Other Accomplishments:

- > Field Representative was given a new motorcycle to assist in visits and food distributions.
- > Several children were treated in the hospital for various ailments.
- > Mosquito nets, blankets, and mattresses were supplied as needed.
- > April, Birthday Month, brought a birthday party for all with a nice meal and celebration.
- > Christmas was celebrated with a festive meal for families and gifts for the children.
